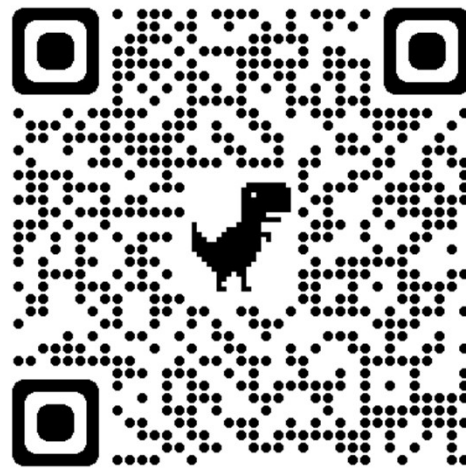


Adopt-a-Drain

- Fill out the waiver and get ready to care for your drain!

Cleaning Your Drain

- Read and follow the safety instructions on the website
- Use equipment/materials of your choice to clean on and around your drain
- Fill out the field report form to track your impact
- Repeat every two weeks and before major precipitation or melt events

Benefits of Participating

- Make your community cleaner
- Help improve the quality of stormwater, Delaware Run, and the Olentangy River
- Help prevent street flooding due to covered storm drains
- Notice potential issues before they become actual issues
